

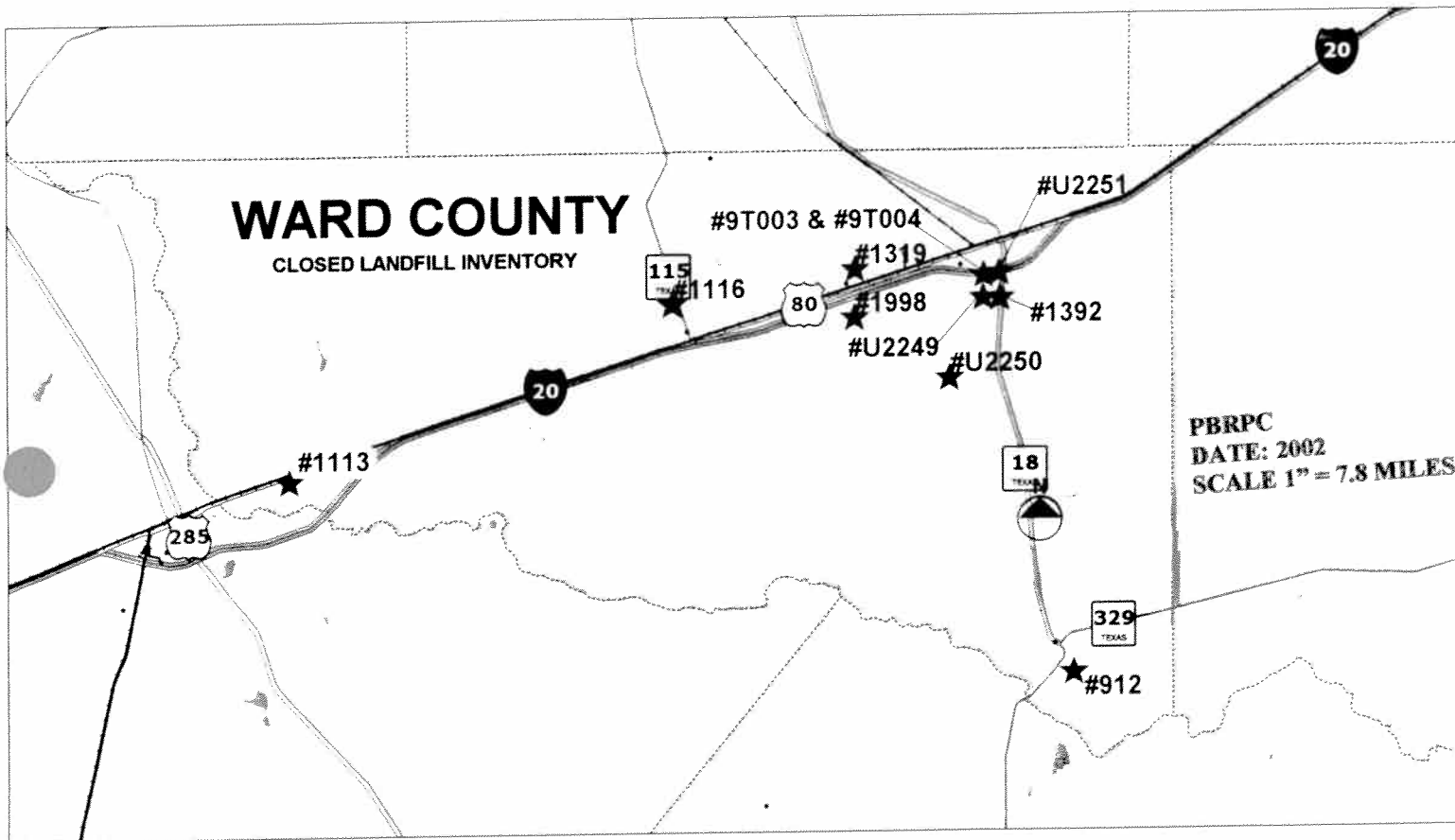

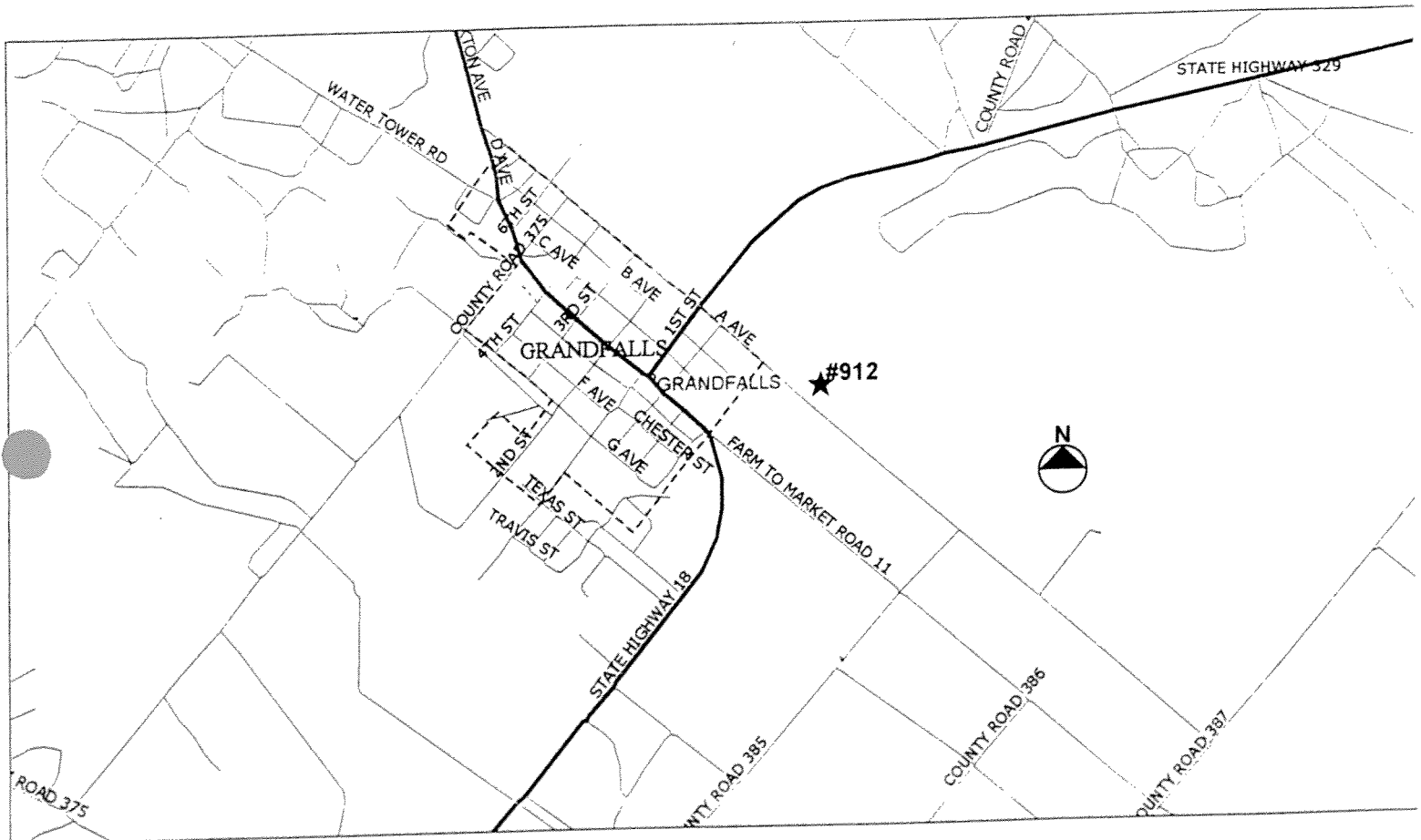

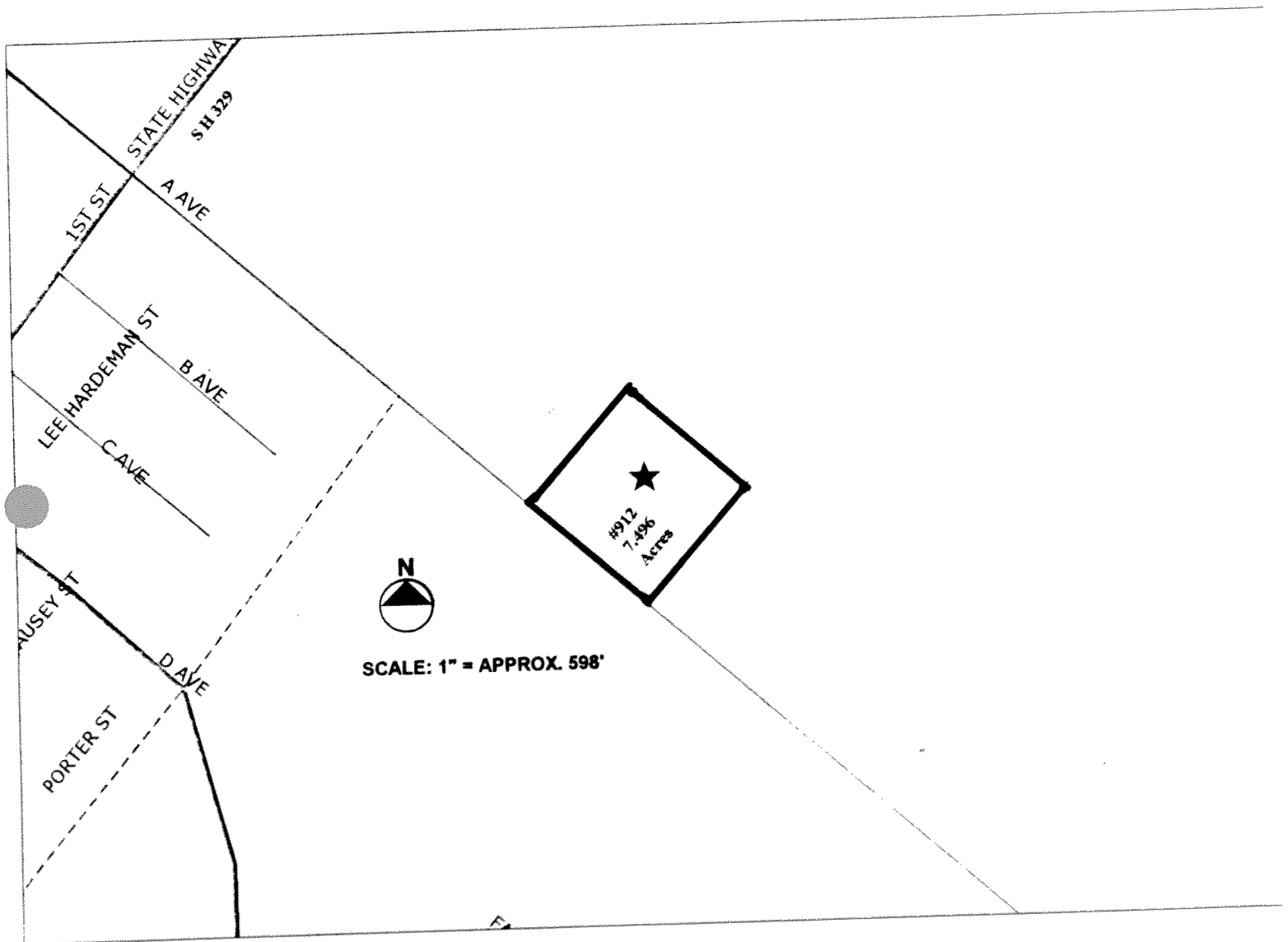


GENERAL LOCATION MAP

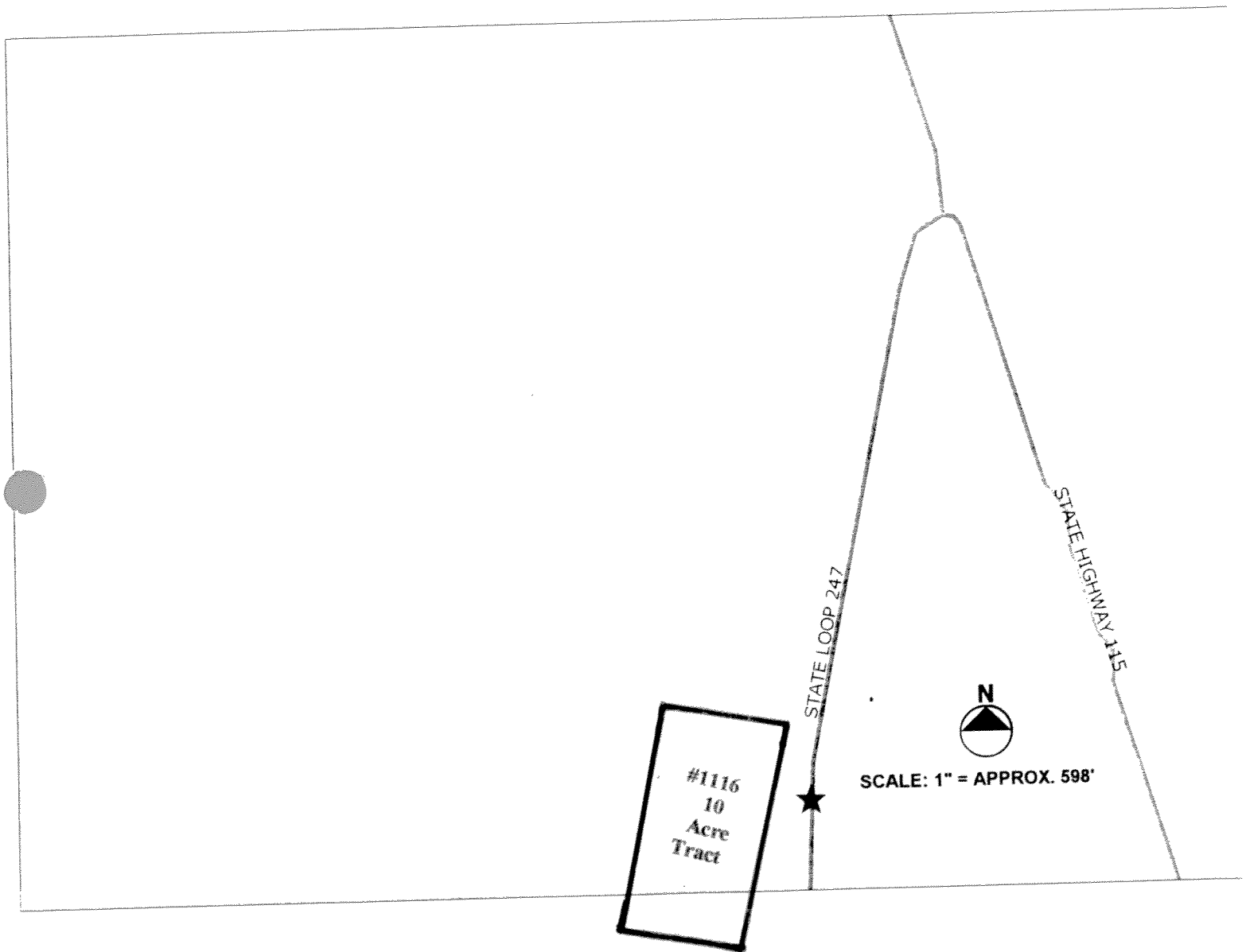


GENERAL LOCATION MAP

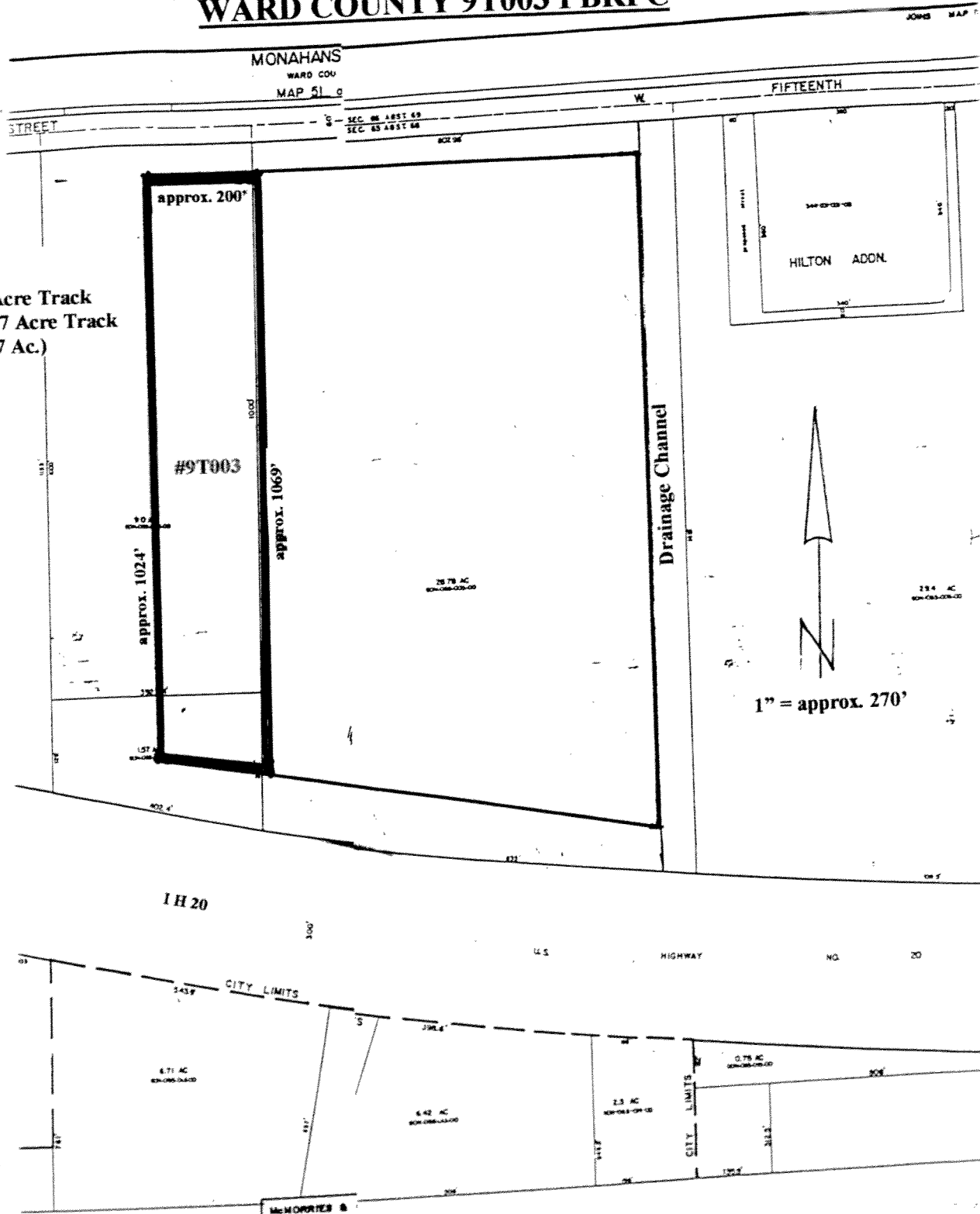
GENERAL LOCATION MAP

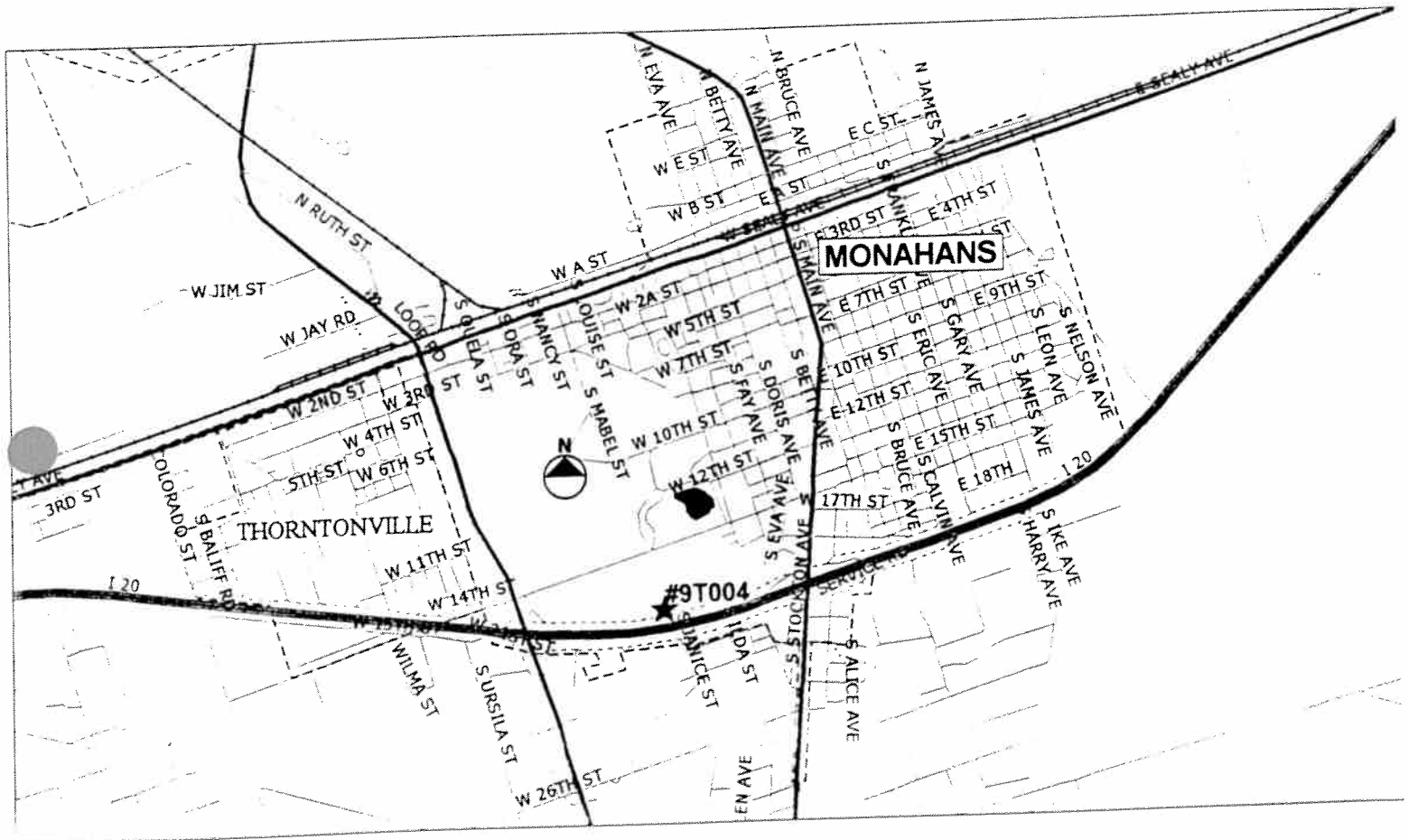

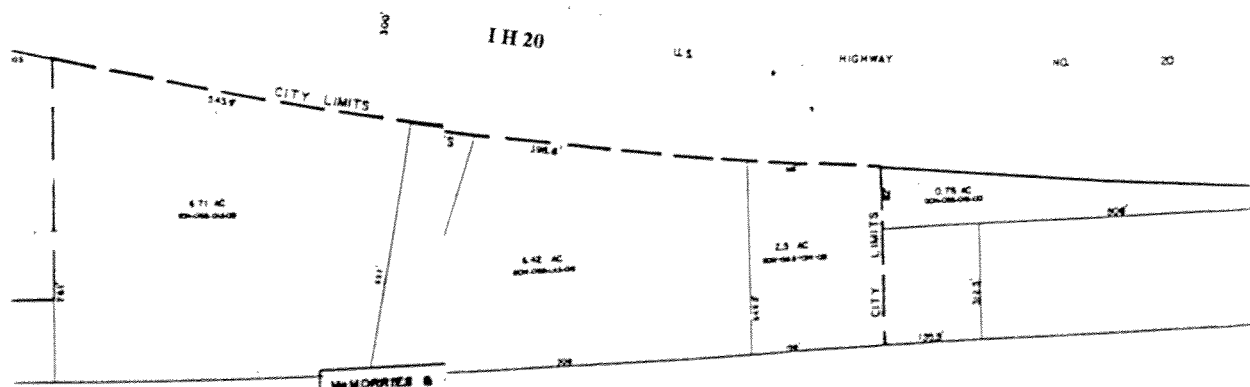
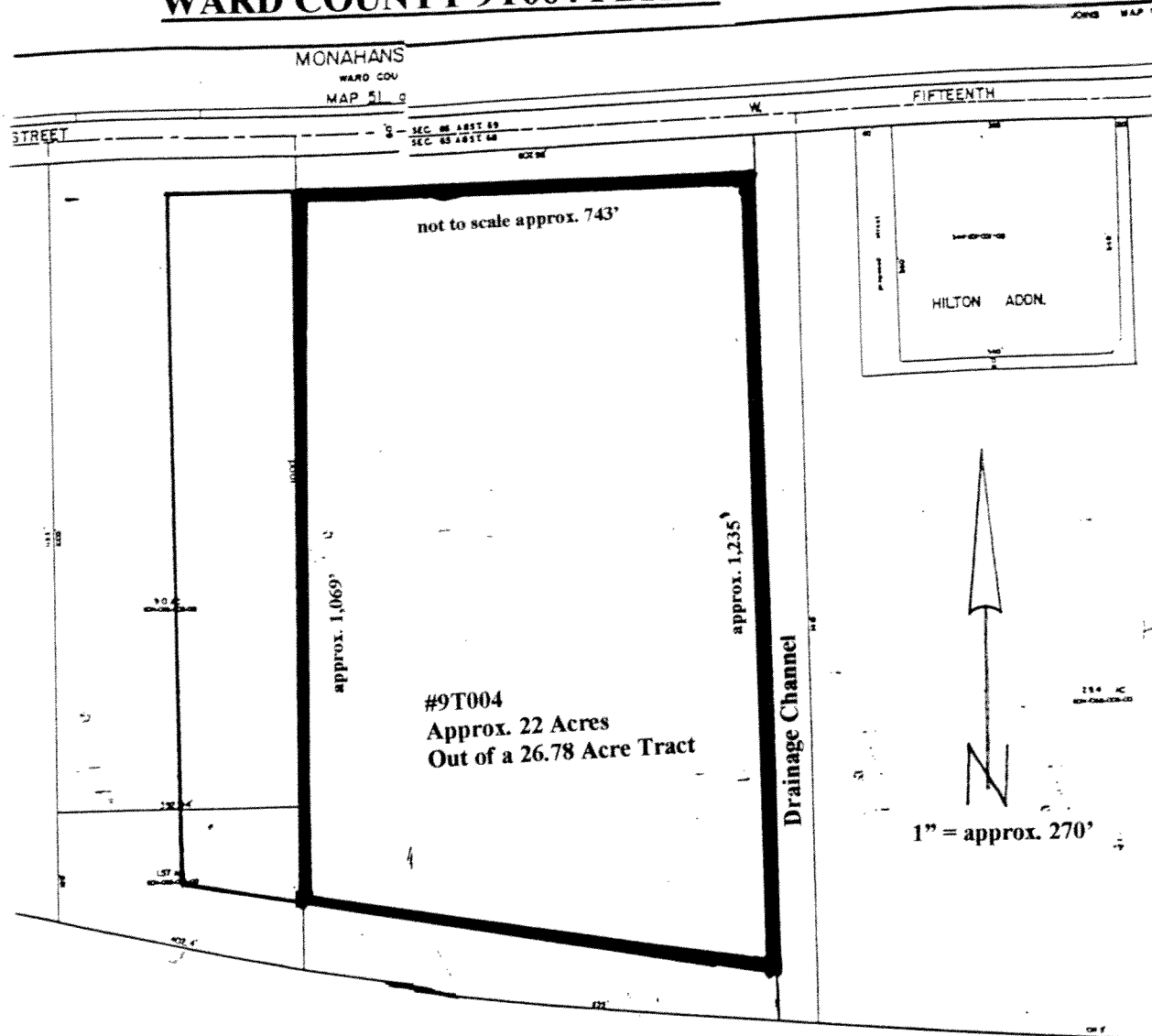
