Each year, the Panhandle region receives an allocation of federal homeland security funding through the Texas Division of Emergency Management. The Domestic Preparedness Advisory Committee (DPAC) is responsible for developing recommendations as to how those funds should be used to support regional preparedness goals. The types of projects typically supported by DPAC are those that will have regional impact and help to improve the Region's overall preparedness capabilities.
