## **TEXAS COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT EXAM REQUIREMENTS**

To be eligible to sit for an examination, an examinee **must:**

1. Bring to the examination site, and display upon request, identification issued by the state or federal government **with the examinee's photograph** (valid state driver's license or identification card is preferred, law enforcement agency identification with photo, or United States government issued photo identification).
2. Know their correct TCOLE PID
3. Report on time
4. Not disrupt the examination
5. Comply with all of the written and verbal instructions of the proctor

## **EXAM ADMINISTRATION REQUIREMENTS**

The examinee **shall not:**

1. Bring into the examination room ANY books, notes, or other written material related to the content of the examination
2. Refer to, use, or possess any such written material in the examination room
3. Bring into the examination room any cellular phones, cellular watches, pagers, or other such devices that are internet enabled
4. Give or receive answers or communicate in any manner with another examinee during the examination
5. Bring food or drinks into the testing area
6. Communicate any of the content of an examination to another at any time
7. Steal, copy, or in any way reproduce any part of the examination
8. Engage in any deceptive or fraudulent act to gain admission
9. Engage in any deceptive or fraudulent act during or after an examination
10. Solicit, encourage, direct, assist, or aid another person to violate any provision of these requirements or to compromise the integrity of the examination
